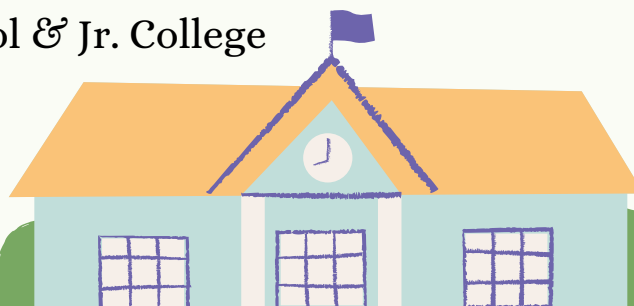

We also have started with foundation classes for Mathematics across all classes early in the morning before school begins. The response of the students for these classes have been fabulous!!

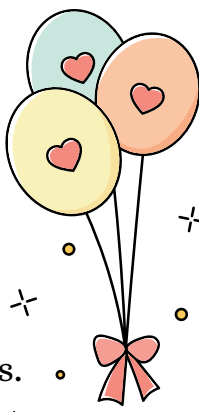
I believe in upholding high standards with an absolute commitment to strive to understand and improve the educational process, using team strategies, while wholly centering on student achievement.

So, let us embrace this exciting journey of learning! Let us ask questions, explore new ideas, and never stop growing. The world is waiting for us!

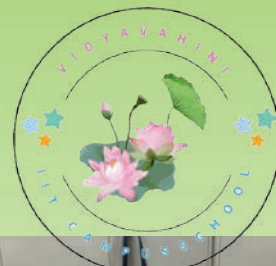
