IIT Campus School & Jr. College

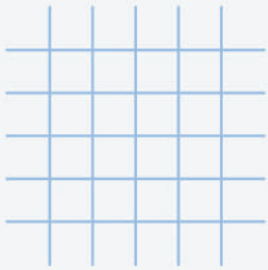
